WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- 1/4 cup Flour
- 1/8 cup Water
- 1 Bowl
- Mixer

WHAT DO TO:

First, pour your plain white flour and water into a bowl. Mix them together until they are smooth. You do not want it to be too thick or drippy. Add flour until it looks like glue. That's it! Now experiment with food colors to add some extra cool to your glue.

Recently, I went on a huge adventure around the world. Did you know there are seven continents? We live on the North American continent. Check out my pictures from each stop.

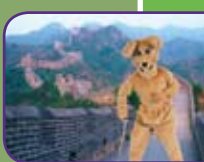
AFRICA: While in Africa, I had to see the great pyramids. The one you see behind me is the oldest of them all and one of the great wonders of the world.
