



When repossessed vehicles are sold by open auction style, offers are accepted in writing, in person or via fax at any branch location, the first initial offer must be in writing and then may be increased verbally, or via e-mail. Offer forms, and a list of repo's we have for sale with the current offers, are available by contacting NorthWest Plus Credit Union. The repo's are available to be test driven. To test drive you will need to show a valid drivers license and proof of insurance. Potential buyers are more then welcome to have the vehicle inspected by their own mechanic at their own expense during business hours prior to 2:00 on the final day.

Offers are open to public knowledge, and counter offers must be \$100.00 higher then the previous high offer. We do not stop the bidding until the final posted date and time. Upon the deadline the highest offer is accepted unless there are multiple interested parties that show up in person at the Everett main office on the final date at the closing time, in which case it becomes a verbal bidding session until we reach the highest bid.

Upon acceptance of an offer the bidder has 24 hours to provide cash, cashiers check, certified funds, or funds transfer. Sales tax and license fees are the responsibility of the buyer. **Vehicles are sold AS-IS.**
