ATLANTA, GA, January 16, 2007---CDC Federal Credit Union (CDC FCU) in collaboration with Volunteer Decatur and other local area businesses, sponsored a home for the 5th Annual Martin Luther King, Jr. (MLK, Jr.) Service Project. The project directly helps fixed or low-income senior citizen homeowners in the Decatur, Georgia Community by contributing building supplies and professional services for home repairs and yard work.

By “adopting” a home, CDC FCU was able to assist the Hill family with the restructuring of their front porch, back porch railing and a new basement door. These minor repairs not only helped improve the appearance and safety of the Hill home, but also contributed to the enhancement of the surrounding neighborhood.

“Through the MLK Service Project we were able to give back through sponsorship dollars, as well as work closely with residents and local volunteers to improve the overall quality of life within their community,” said Sharon Cook, Vice President Marketing Services.

The MLK, Jr. Service Project is a collaboration of Decatur Preservation Alliance, Decatur Housing Authority, Decatur Business Association, Community Center of South Decatur, and the South Decatur Community Development Corporation.

CDC FCU not only cares about helping the community through donating and volunteering, the credit union also offers the Georgia Dream 1st Time Homebuyer Program. This program helps those who are 1st time homebuyers that may not meet traditional down payment requirements or who lack an extensive credit history.

Since CDC FCU began its partnership with The Georgia Department of Community Affairs in 2005, over \$4 million in mortgages have been written for young couples, single mothers, recent graduates, life-long renters and working immigrant families.
