VISA Debit/Cash Card Information

VISA Debit/Cash Cards sure can make it easy to pay for your purchases and to access cash. At the same time if you do not protect your card it can also make your life miserable.

All Credit Union issued VISA Debit/Cash Cards are currently blocked from use in the following states:

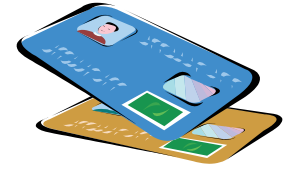
Georgia—Florida
California-Hawaii
New Mexico—Texas

If you plan to travel to any of these states please notify the credit union before you leave of your dates of travel. We can then make arrangements to temporarily remove the block from your card during your travel. .

The blocking of the cards is due to high fraud activity originating in these states. While the credit union has the most up to date fraud protection on all plastic cards the criminals are always one or two steps ahead. Please monitor your accounts. If a transaction appears that you did not authorize please notify the credit union immediately to reduce your liability. - *Daily Cash Limit \$300
- *Daily Purchase Limit \$700
- *To pay for purchases without using your PIN you can use the



“Credit” feature at checkout. Your purchase will be automatically deducted from your checking account. If you do not have a checking account it will be deducted from your share account.

*You can personalize your PIN Number at most ATM Machines.
*When your Visa Debit/Cash Card is expiring, the card is good through the end of the month that is embossed on the front of your card. You will receive a replacement card by the end of the month. You will use the same PIN that is currently being used.

*If you enter an incorrect PIN at an ATM machine more than 3 times the machine will keep your card. Please notify the CU to get another card and to reset your PIN counter
*Replacement Card fee is \$5.00
*Insufficient Funds Fee is \$25.00

After dinner we will conduct the 49th Annual Meeting of Shareholders.

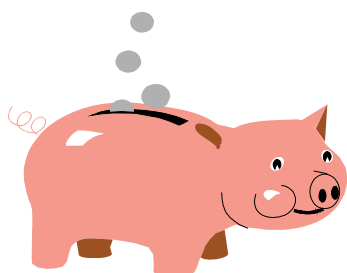
At that time elections will be held for volunteer members to serve a two-year term on the Board of Directors. There are three (3) positions up for Election. If anyone is interested in running for
