1. Submit the completed application
2. Mail the application, high school/college transcripts, copy of letter of acceptance (if you are a high school senior) and two letters of recommendation by **April 30, 2010** to:

Please make certain to provide all information requested as incomplete applications will not be considered. If necessary, you may make photocopies and attach any additional pages needed to complete your application.

Who is Eligible?

1. You are eligible to apply if you are a primary member of Carolina Postal Credit Union with your own account. If you are not a member, you may join CPCU before submitting your scholarship application and become eligible to apply. Your accounts (checking, ATM, savings etc.) must be in good standing with no delinquent or charged-off loans.
2. Also, you must be a graduating high school senior or current college student who will enroll in an undergraduate course of study during the 2010 school year at an accredited two year or four year college, university or vocational-technical school in the United States.

How Are Recipients Selected?

The Iona Berry Memorial Scholarships are awarded to members who demonstrate academic excellence, citizenship, community, and school involvement. **Only complete applications will be considered. The application and all requested information must be received by April 30 2010.**

How Much Are the Awards?

Carolina Postal Credit Union will award up to three \$1,000 scholarships and four \$500 scholarships directly to the recipient.
