DO YOU HAVE AN INACTIVE ACCOUNT?

■ What is an Inactive Account?

It's a share (savings) account with a balance under \$250 with no activity for 12 months, including deposits or withdrawals, and no other savings or loan accounts.

■ What happens if my account becomes inactive?

A \$2.50 inactive account fee will be charged to your account each month until you become active again.

■ How can I prevent my account from becoming inactive?

68th Annual Meeting of the Nebraska State Employees Credit Union

Pursuant to Article XVI of the by-laws of the Nebraska State Employees Credit Union, 2009 elections to fill vacancies in various offices of the credit union will be as follows:

The Nominating Committee has made the following nominations:

Board of Directors: Three vacancies for a three-year term each.

Any credit union member that meets the membership requirements may have their names placed in nomination by the following method:

Such nominations shall be made by petition signed by not less than 45 members of the credit union. Such members must be members as of January 1, 2009. The petition shall state the name and address of the person being nominated, a brief statement of the qualifications and biographical data similar to that listed for other nominees. The petition shall only nominate one person for one vacancy, shall be accompanied by a signed certificate that they are agreeable to the nomination and will serve if elected, and shall be delivered to the Secretary of the credit union no later than March 6, 2009. Such delivery may be accomplished by delivering such addressed to Secretary, Nebraska State Employees Credit Union, 330 S. 16, Lincoln, NE 68508.

If at the close of business on March 6, 2009, there is more than one person nominated for a position, voting will take place by ballot at the three credit union offices (330 S. 16, Lincoln, NE; Beatrice State Development Center, Beatrice, NE; and 1715 North Bell Street, Fremont, NE) during business hours on April 20 through April 23, 2009. In addition, ballot boxes will be available at the Annual Meeting in Lincoln. The election will not be conducted by ballot box and there will be no nominations from the floor when there is only one nominee for each position to be filled.

If you would like to vote but are unable to come to the credit union office or to the Annual Meeting, you may receive an absentee ballot by submitting a written request to the credit union, which must be received by the end of the business day, March 31, 2009. Absentee ballots will be mailed on or before April 10, 2009 and must be received by the credit union by midnight, April 17, 2009.
