UIECU Participates in Money Smart Week & Helps Clean Up C-U

Champaign, IL – The U of I Employees Credit Union (UIECU) will participate in the Champaign County Money Smart Week (April 18-25) and help Champaign County residents clean up their records. UIECU will be holding a Shred Event throughout the day on Saturday, April 25.

Participants can bring up to five boxes of documents and watch them shredded, for FREE! The credit union will hold two separate events, from 9 am – Noon at the Five Points Branch located at 206 East University Avenue in Urbana, and again from 12:30 pm – 3 pm at the First Street Branch located at 2201 South First Street in Champaign.

The credit union holds three to four shred events throughout the year for members. The events offer residents a chance to safely dispose of their unwanted sensitive documents. As part of Money Smart Week, Saturday's events will be open to the public.

“With the increases in identity theft, we want to make sure that our members are protected,” said Greg Anderson, Executive Vice President. “Many people simply throw away documents with critical information, leaving them vulnerable. We offer a chance to get rid of all those unwanted documents you never have time to shred, safely and securely.”
