



FACTS What does Jeep Country FCU do with your personal information?

Why? Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some, but not all, sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What? The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product(s) or service(s) you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and Income
- Account balances and Payment history
- Account transactions and Credit history

When you are no longer our member, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

How? All financial companies need to share members' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their members' personal information; the reasons Jeep Country FCU chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

For our everyday business purposes – such as to process your transactions, maintain your account(s), respond to court orders and legal investigations, or report to credit bureaus	Yes	No

How does Jeep Country FCU protect my personal information?	<p>To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with Federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.</p> <p>Jeep Country FCU regularly tests and assesses our information security measures, systematically trains employees, and adopts upgrades and enhancements as necessary to protect your information.</p>
How does Jeep Country FCU collect my personal information?	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Open an account or apply for a loan• Show your driver's license or use your credit or debit card• Make deposits or withdrawals from your account <p>We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.</p>
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness• Affiliates from using your information to market to you• Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you
Definitions	
Affiliates	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Our affiliates include Jeep Country FCU
Nonaffiliates	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Jeep Country FCU does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.
Joint marketing	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Our joint marketing partners include investment, insurance, and other financial services companies.
