At branches where the swirl logo appears (show logo graphic), you can access your account and have a member service representative answer your questions every time you visit. More than 3,000 credit unions nationwide enable you to perform your financial transactions at your convenience. Any Credit Union Service Center can take care of all your business, including:*

- Deposits
- Transfers
- Statement printouts
- Withdrawals
- Balance inquiries

All you need to do is provide the member service representative at the Service Center with your account number and a valid photo ID, and you're on your way. Credit unions are known for working together cooperatively to better serve members, and the participating Credit Union Service Centers in Maine are ready and waiting to provide you with the same great credit union service you're accustomed to. Look for the swirl logo on the door welcoming you. This service will be available to all members on May 1, 2009. Ask us for more details.

*Some restrictions may apply, based on a location's cash availability. Availability of funds deposited to your account will depend on your credit union's policy. Funds may not be immediately available.

Effective June 1, 2009, rates will be 0.65% on regular Share Accounts, IRA Shares and all Club Accounts. Rates will be 1.00% on all Super Share Accounts and 0.25% on Share Draft (Checking) Accounts. Please contact us with any questions or concerns.
