4. Declare your Career Goals.
5. Provide three (3) Letters of Reference; one of which must be from your High School Guidance Counselor.
6. Submit a TYPED essay (*Written on a credit union related topic of your choice between 500 and 1,000 words in length. Examples: personal experience, family experience, credit union philosophy, credit union needs, etc.*)
7. Submit your completed application along with the above requested items by March 16, 2012. **All requested information must be included. Incomplete or late applications will be disqualified.**
