Be aware that Blue Flame Credit Union (or any other financial institution) would never contact members via email with such a request. Should you receive this or a similar Email message, please do not comply with the requests.

Due to recent activity, we will suspend any activity on your account in order to allow us to investigate this matter further. If you believe that this action may have been taken in error, or, if you feel that your account may have been tampered with, please respond to this message so that we can provide additional information and work with you to resolve this issue. After responding to the message, we ask that you allow at least 24 hours for the case to be investigated. Emailing us before that time will result in delays. We apologize in advance for any inconvenience this may cause you and we would like to thank you for your cooperation as we review this matter.

If you received this notice and you are not the authorized account holder, please be aware that it is in violation of National Association of Federal Credit Union policy to represent oneself as another National Association of Federal Credit Union user. Such action may also be in violation of local, national, and/or international law. National Association of Federal Credit Union is committed to assist law enforcement with any inquires related to attempts to misappropriate personal information with the intent to commit fraud or theft. Information will be provided at the request of law enforcement agencies to ensure that perpetrators are prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.
