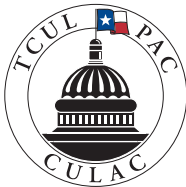

Why Sign Up for Deduct-a-Buck?

The Deduct-a-Buck program gives millions of credit union members a voice in the political process. When we all give a little, it adds up to real grass roots power for Texas credit unions.

Authorize your credit union to deduct as much or as little as you'd like from your share draft account (checking) or share account (savings).

Sign Up Today

It's fast and easy and completely voluntary. Say YES! to Texas Credit Unions.

Contributions to TCUL PAC/CULAC are not deductible for federal tax purposes, are strictly voluntary and will be used for political purposes. You have the right to refuse to contribute without any reprisal. CULAC is required to collect the name and mailing address of individuals who contribute \$50 or more. The law requires political action committees to report the following information for individuals whose contributions exceed \$100 in a calendar year: name, address, occupation and employer. All information will be kept confidential unless required by law. You must be a US Citizen or a person lawfully admitted for permanent residency in the United States.

The amounts listed above are merely suggestions, and I may contribute more or less than the guidelines suggest. In addition, CUNA and my Credit Union will not favor or disadvantage anyone by reason of the amount of their contribution or their decision not to contribute. I have the right to refuse to contribute without reprisal.

My payroll deduction will continue until I notify Payroll in writing of any change. The submission of a new deduction authorization form will supersede any previous authorizations for this payroll deduction. I have the right to terminate this deduction at any time by providing written notification (or email) to the Payroll Department. I understand my notice must be received by Payroll one week prior to a payday to allow for processing time.
