This year we have three-\$500 scholarships available for members who are currently enrolled in grades 9-12, two-\$500 scholarships for any member currently enrolled as a full-time college student and one-\$1,000 scholarship available for a student enrolled in high school or a full-time college student.

Applicants must be a member of the credit union and currently enrolled in high school or a full-time college program (9 unit minimum), with a current GPA of 2.5 or better. All applications will be reviewed for eligibility and awards will be given via random drawing from all eligible applicants at our annual meeting in April, 2010.

The application deadline is April 1, 2010. Please be sure to submit your application, essay and proof of grade point average. An incomplete or late application will not be accepted.
